

Competition - Design a House Banner

Background



In September 2019 we will mark 100 years since the Parmiter's House system was formed at the Bethnal Green school.

In celebration and recognition of this important tradition and

valuable aspect of school life we are planning to commission a set of House Banners which will hang in the main school hall for very many years to come.

All students both past and present are immensely proud of their association with a House and enthusiastically embrace the camaraderie and the activities that make up the House Championship competitions throughout the year.

Competition - How to Enter

All members of the Parmiter's community, both adults and children, are invited to submit their design ideas for a House Banner. You could produce a design for one or for all six.

Entries should be given to Mr Brown, Head of Houses, by September 20th 2019. These can be produced by hand using the attached template or alternatively e-mailed to Mr Brown at a.brown@parmiters.herts.sch.uk

You are most welcome to use computers and the files you send can be in a variety of formats. As well as Microsoft Office we use both Adobe Illustrator, Photoshop and CorelDraw in school.

The best designs will be those that are simple and easy to produce and it is therefore important to keep the detail minimal, especially as we will not be printing onto fabric.

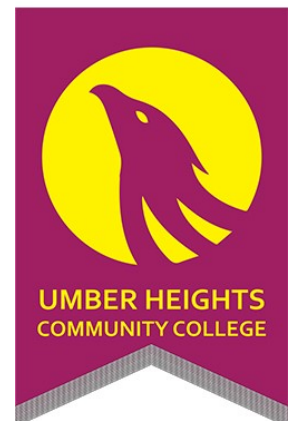
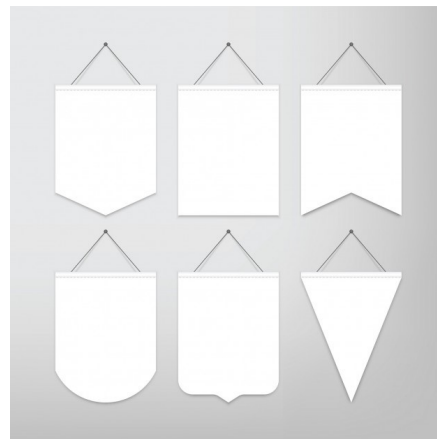
Important Information

House Names

Beven	Red	Chairman of Parmiter's Foundation from 1886-1911, Thomas Beven gave unstintingly of his time for a quarter of a century and performed the opening ceremony of the new school in Approach Road in 1887.
Carter	Yellow	Named after Elizabeth Carter who gave a site for the Parmiter's Almshouses and School in 1723 and bequeathed income from property in Bethnal Green for the benefit of the charity.
Lee	Green	Named after William Lee, the first Treasurer of Parmiter's Charity, who at his death in 1710 left a large sum of money towards the building of a School-room in Bethnal Green, in addition to smaller sums intended to benefit the education of poor boys.
Mayhew	White	Edward Mayhew's generosity enabled the Charity to purchase land at Cambridge Heath, and at his death in 1724 he left to the Foundation income from further property in Bethnal Green.
Renvoize	Blue	Under the terms of his Will, Peter Renvoize bequeathed a substantial sum to the Foundation on his death in 1842 and hoped "that the trustees and their successors will not object to keep my family vault in Bethnal Green church yard and the tomb thereof always in good repair and condition".
Woolley	Purple	An Old boy of the School, G.H.Woolley was a Second Lieutenant in the 9th Battalion of the London Regiment (Territorial Force) who was awarded the Victoria Cross for bravery in April 1915.

Guidance

- Designs should be kept simple so they are easily produced. The aim is to use an applique method using different textile based materials.
- Consideration should be given to the shape of the banner, how it hangs and the orientation of the design. See the examples given.
- Ideally each House will have its own logo/symbol which is simple and links to the background of the person it is named after. Consider creating a Pictogram style image which does rely on words. See examples of common pictograms.
