



A LEVEL RESULTS: THE WAY FORWARD - 2025

For those of you progressing to Higher Education: -

1. If you have met the demands of your firm (UCAS) offer you will receive confirmation of the place in Track. Fairly quickly, your university will be in touch. Do nothing. Wait for the confirmation and then react to it.

2. If you have just missed the demands of your firm choice but the university is still considering you it will show in Track. You unfortunately just have to wait but, if necessary, you can phone the institution on results day (THURSDAY) to find out timescales.

3. If you do not have a place at your firm choice (either by route 1 or route 2 above), but have met the demands of your insurance offer, wait for the confirmation and react to it.

4. If you have missed the demands of both your offers, you will be in Clearing. Clearing places are advertised even before results day, but no one can be accepted until mid afternoon on results day. Take your time looking, contact universities and find out if they will take you.

5. DO NOT ACCEPT A COURSE JUST TO GAIN A HIGHER EDUCATION PLACE. Do your research. Places will remain on offer well beyond Thursday afternoon! The UCAS site will carry Clearing vacancies from the day of the results, as will websites of the universities themselves. There are always a lot of options and you should take time to decide.

6. If at any point you wish to give up your offer and take something else in clearing, you can by using Track.
