GCSE Results - Key Information for Thursday 20 August

As promised, we write to you ahead of results day to remind you of the timings and ensure you have key information easily to hand. All information sent regarding results, next steps and post-results services is also available on the school website [here](#) under 'GCSE & A Level Exam Information and Letters (including JCQ documents)'.

Issuing of Results

GCSE results (and results for other qualifications taken in Summer 2026) will be emailed to students at 8.00am on Thursday 20 August. Due to the volume of emails being sent out, please be patient as emails are not always received immediately.

The first email to be sent will give the student's results statement. This will show the grade awarded in each subject.

The exam boards do not issue students with individual statements that show a breakdown of the marks they achieved in each component of the qualification. However, students are often keen to know this. We will therefore make this information available to students as soon as possible. **Students will receive a second email from the exams platform, Exams Assist/School Workspace, as early in the day as we can manage, which will show your results along with a breakdown of the marks that contributed to the student's overall grade.**

All emails will go to the student's school email address. Unfortunately, results cannot be sent to other email addresses as the statements and emails are automatically generated by the school's data management system / exams platform. We will send the first email at 8.00am, although please be patient as we know these do not always send, or are not always received, immediately.

We will not be printing results statements unless you require a verified results statement printed on headed paper; which will only be required if you are applying to other schools or colleges who have requested this. If required and you have not already done so, please contact Mrs Hicks (l.hicks@parmiters.herts.sch.uk). These can be collected after 9.00am on Thursday 20 August from Reception.

The deadline for registering is 10.00am on Friday 21 August.** Please take careful note of this deadline, as late registration may not be possible or may jeopardise a student's access to courses, particularly in the event of oversubscription.

If you have not made the entry requirements to Parmiter's Sixth Form, or not met the entry requirements to study your first choice A Level subjects, you can make an appointment to speak to a member of the Sixth Form Team. **We respectfully ask that students and parents do not contact Heads of Department or teaching staff directly to enquire about places on A Level courses.**
