To understand this homework timetable, students need to know their Science group and the subject they study in each option block (Options A, B, C and D). This information is sent to students' school email accounts at the start of the academic year.

Additional Notes

- **Science** homework will be set according to each student's Science group, with two homeworks each for Biology, Chemistry and Physics set across the two-week timetable. Students should refer to their timetable to confirm their Science group.
- In **GCSE English** all students will have one reading and revision homework a week (set centrally) as part of their English homework allocation. An additional fortnightly English homework may be set at the class teacher's discretion, as and when appropriate. Due to some homework being set centrally, it may show up on a student's timeline before the allocated homework slot.
- **Option subjects** may choose to set homework in only two of the three allocated homework slots.
- In **GCSE PE**, teachers will set 1 piece of homework over the two-week timetable. Students are expected to complete this in detail. Students will be asked to complete additional homework whilst completing their NEA in the summer of Year 10.
- In **GCSE History** students will be expected to complete either 20 minutes or 100% Weekly Goal of Tassomai Quizzes as part of their homework
