

Summary of Performance Measures at GCSE

The table below shows key performance indicators at GCSE calculated for all students – the cohort is then split into students entitled to Pupil Premium (PP) and those not entitled to Pupil Premium (non-PP).

Initially, it should be noted that for this year group the average KS2 point score of the PP students is below that of the non-PP students, indicating that as a group they started from a lower academic baseline. PP students were represented disproportionately highly amongst those pupils with special education needs (SEN).

Consequently, the PP group contained some students who completed a reduced curriculum tailored to their skill and abilities. These reduced curricula were designed to meet the individual students' needs with no regard for the negative impact on the School's headline figures (such as the impact on Progress 8 if a student does not fill all 8 "slots").

Despite this, the overall Progress 8 score for our disadvantaged students is 0.26. This suggests that these students achieved just over a quarter of a grade higher per subject than the average for all students nationally. This is an improvement on the previous academic year where students achieved on average half a grade lower per subject.

It should also be noted that the PP category contains only 20 students and is therefore more affected by extreme or outlying results. Additionally, some of the highest and lowest Progress 8 scores in the year group belonged to PP students.

In order to continue to improve outcomes for our PP students we will continue to tailor the curriculum to individual students in response to their needs even if this negatively affects the key performance measures.
