Dear Year 13 Students and their Parents/Carers

Please find below the schedule for assessments the Year 13 students will sit between Monday 7 November and Friday 25 November 2022. The time of the assessment is determined by the option block in which students study that subject. For example, 13B Economics is for those students who are in the Economics class in option block B.

Students should note that some assessments take place at times when they would not normally have a lesson in that subject, but instead have a study period. These sessions are marked with an asterisk (\*) on the schedule below.

These **assessments will take place during lessons** and will provide a valuable opportunity for students to:

- Engage in a revision programme and refine their revision skills before the Year 13 trial examinations.
- Practise the skill of working under timed, examination style conditions.
- Allow students and staff to pinpoint knowledge or skills that need to improve.

You will note that not all subjects are included on the schedule. In some subjects, students are working on NEA and should remain fully focused on this area of the course. In other subjects, this window is not the right time in the course to be assessing students; these subjects will provide assessment opportunities at other points in the year when the feedback for students and staff will be more valuable. However, the vast majority of students will have some formal assessment during this period.

Students will be provided with guidance on the content of these assessments by their subject teacher.

**As all assessments are taking place during lessons, there is no study leave for students during this period and all students are expected to attend all lessons as normal during this period.** If a student misses an assessment it may not be possible to reschedule; this will be at the discretion of the Head of Department.

Students who have agreed access arrangements will have these administered during these assessments. Where it is reasonable to do so, these students will sit their assessments with their class. However, for some students it may be necessary to vary the timings of assessments slightly from the timetable below; if this is the case, the students will be informed.
