Apprenticeship Awareness Evening (Years 9 -13) - Tuesday 4 February

We will be holding an in-person **Apprenticeship Awareness Evening** on **Tuesday 4 February** from **7.00pm to 8.00pm** in the **Main Hall** for all Year 9 to 13 students and their parents/carers. The session will cover essential information such as who offers apprenticeships, an explanation of the different levels, where to find them and apply, and what the application and interview process may entail.

This will be an excellent opportunity for students and parents/carers to interact directly with professionals and apprentices. Building on the success of last year's evening, alongside a general introductory presentation on apprenticeships, we will have a number of different speakers attending to talk about their experiences of apprenticeships. This includes a number of former students who are currently undertaking apprenticeships in Clinical Trials at **GSK**, Engineering at **Rolls Royce**, Audit and Finance at **BDO**, Sales at **i-Media** and a Police Constable Degree Apprenticeship with the **Met Police Force**.

We will also have a former student who is now a Senior Counsel at **CMS**, a **global Law Firm**, talking about **Solicitor Apprenticeships**. Applications for the CMS Solicitor Apprenticeship open on Monday 10 February and they also offer Scholarship and Work Experience Programmes.

After the presentation, there will then be an opportunity to speak directly to the alumni to ask any questions you may have about their apprenticeships and experience.
