<p>The majority of students will study A level subjects in three of the four option blocks. Exceptions to this are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Students who fulfil the criteria to study 4 subjects at A level, and who choose to do so. ○ Students studying Further Mathematics who complete A Levels in Mathematics and Further Mathematics, hence the subject being allocated across two option blocks. Students choosing Further Mathematics must choose two further subjects (not Mathematics). <p>In addition to their A Level subjects, all Year 12 students participate in:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ The Sixth Form enrichment programme, that includes a weekly timetabled session. ○ An induction programme that includes taught Study Skills sessions. <p>All students are given the opportunity to complete an EPQ (Extended Project Qualification).</p>
