Dear Parents and Carers

Year 13 A Level Art Examination - Tuesday 30 April, Wednesday 1 and Thursday 2 May 2024

As you will be aware, the Year 13 A Level Art examination will be taking place on Tuesday 30 April, Wednesday 1 and Thursday 2 May. Students need to **go straight to AR1 at 8.35am** on all examination days and not to their form room. Students who are late will not be allowed to enter the examination room. They must adhere to the Sixth Form dress code.

Students must come prepared with their preparatory work for Component 2 (their current project). Any student who does not have their sketchbook / A2 sheets / preparatory work with them at the start of the examination, will be unable to submit their work for assessment as part of Component 2. The preparatory work equates to 75% of the overall Component 2 grade and it is imperative that work is completed and refined prior to the examination days. Students will hand in this work to their teacher in the exam room before the examination begins, as this is an exam board requirement.

Between now and their examination, students must purchase their canvas/paper/cardboard or anything they are working on for the final piece and then use their lesson time to prepare their pieces. Students have been provided with the equipment list attached.

All preparatory work for this project will be marked alongside the final piece to determine their Component 2 mark. The preparatory work and the outcome that they create within the two day examination equates to 40% of their overall A Level Art grade. They will **not** be able to refine or add to their work afterwards.

If students have any questions regarding the examination, please encourage them to speak to their Art teacher in their next lesson. Students who will have extra time due to access arrangements will be spoken to regarding the timings for this.

Year 13 A Level Art Examination Tuesday 30 April, Wednesday 1 and Thursday 2 May 2024

Students must come to AR1 at **8.35am on Tuesday 30 April** to set up and register. Students who are late will not be allowed to enter the examination room.

Your exam is 3 days long (15 hours). On the first day, you must bring in the following:	
1.	Sketchbook.
2. obse	All work presented in the A2 clearbook presentation folder, each sheet clearly named - ervational page, artist/experiment sheet, development of ideas, maquette.
3.	Any other preparatory materials if you have made any, such as 3D responses.
4.	Prepared canvas/board/paper for final piece.
5.	Good quality coloured primary image at least A4 size to work from.
6.	Art materials e.g. paint, brushes, pens, pencils (we will also have some materials available in the ns).
7.	Apron or old shirt to protect uniform.
8.	If you plan to work on the floor, bring an old cushion!
9.	Plenty of water.
Please remember, all preparatory work needs to be handed in on Tuesday 30 April. Final piece will need to be submitted for assessment at the end of the examination. Without the relevant materials, you may	

be asked to go home and collect them before sitting the examination!
