Year 10 MFL Speaking Examinations

As per the timetable shared in the [letter](#) dated 14 May, Year 10 students have their French, German or Spanish speaking examinations **before** their written examination papers. The speaking examinations will take place between and including Wednesday 3 June and Friday 12 June.

The examination involves a short role-play, a photo card with questions related to one of the topics studied and a short conversation on a different topic to the one on the photo card. Students will be shown the format by their language teacher.


Over the half term break, it is important for students to revise the topics that they have covered this year, paying particular attention to the questions and answers they have prepared on these topics.

A schedule has been drawn up and students will be advised which day has been allocated for each teacher. The teachers will then draw up their own timetable for the day and students will be given the exact time and date of their examination. Absentees will have to take the examination during the lunch hour or after school.

Please note that we will timetable examinations for dual linguists so that they have a few days gap between their French and second language, to allow time for revision.
