GCSE Spring Term 2024 Assessments

We write to provide details of formal assessments that will take place this term and at the start of the Summer term. Our Heads of Department have considered very carefully whether a formal assessment at this point in the course is appropriate. Where subjects have decided to go ahead with an assessment, this is usually because there was one or more elements of the qualification that was not assessed during the trial examinations. These assessments, therefore, provide students with the opportunity to revise, and be tested on, these parts of the course. Other subjects may choose to run shorter, more regular assessments during lesson times.
