Additional Notes

All students will be set one independent reading activity per fortnight as part of their English homework allocation. Other English homework will be set at the class teacher's discretion on the correct night, as and when appropriate. On occasion, students may also receive centrally set revision homework. Where homework is issued centrally, it may show up on a student's timeline before the allocated homework slot.

Option subject may choose to set homework in only two of the three allocated homework slots.

In GCSE PE, teachers will set 1 piece of homework over the two-week timetable. Students are expected to complete this in detail. Students will be asked to complete additional homework whilst completing their NEA in the summer of Year 10.
