Evening Lecture on The Brain for Parents/Carers and Staff Tuesday 5 July at 7.00pm in the Conference Centre

In order to complement the A Level Biology and Psychology courses at Parmiter's, we have arranged for Dr Guy Sutton of Nottingham University to host an interactive study day for A Level students on the topic of the brain. Dr Sutton has also kindly offered to present some of his findings and knowledge to parents/carers and staff of Parmiter's in an evening lecture.

In his professional capacity, Dr Sutton works with medical students at various universities and closely with the police and legal professionals to advise and to educate. He is, in his words, a 'brain enthusiast' and always gives exciting and interesting presentations.
