Dear Parents and Carers

Parmiter's School Transition Days - Wednesday 13 and Thursday 14 July 2022

With the end of the summer term fast approaching, it is time for Year 6 children to begin preparing for Year 7. The transition from primary to secondary school is a key time in every student's school career and creating a smooth transition is vital to ensure your child gets the best possible start in their new school.

Therefore, it is very important that all Year 6 students get the opportunity to visit their new secondary school to experience the surroundings, get a feeling for secondary school life and familiarise themselves with the routines and procedures of a significantly larger school. Transition day school visits can really help allay some of the concerns children may have when making this big step and provide reassurance for Year 6 students over the summer holidays.

Please find below details about the Headmaster's Evening (13 July 2022) and Induction Day (14 July 2022).

Headmaster's Evening Welcome Event – Wednesday 13 July 2022 4.00pm - 7.30pm

The evening will commence at 4.00pm in the Sports Hall. Please don't worry if this time is a little early for you, as an allocated slot has been provided in the carousel later in the evening for you and your child to visit the Sports Hall.

In the Sports Hall you will find:

- Our uniform (DJ Uniforms, Stevenson's and Watford Uniforms) and sports kit (Henry Tilly) providers. Parents/Carers will have an opportunity to purchase uniform and PE kit. Changing facilities will be available.
- The Art Department will have Art packs available for purchase (£5 each, cash only), which contain all the essentials items your child will need for their Art lessons.
- Chorleywood Books will be selling a book bundle comprising 2 x CPG KS3 booklets and a Collins English Gem Dictionary/Thesaurus for £15. Other discounted, recommended reads will also be available for purchase.
- There will be a Chromebook advice table with a representative from Stone Group in attendance to answer any questions about the school Lenovo device that parents/carers have purchased via the school from Freedom Tech. For those using their own Chromebook next year and who have already purchased a school management enrolment licence, our IT support team will also be present to apply the licence, so please bring the device with you. It is important that any files stored on personal chromebooks are backed up before this process takes place. - The Music Department will have staff available to help answer any questions about booking peripatetic music lessons.

Induction Day – Thursday 14 July 2022 8.30am – 2.30pm

Your child will be spending the whole day with us at Parmiter's School on Thursday 14 July and this will be an opportunity for all of our new students to experience the school first hand. The date for this event is agreed with Hertfordshire County Council.

Students should wear appropriate casual clothing and trainers. They will also need to bring snacks, drinks and a packed lunch for the day.

Students will assemble in the main school hall and have a short assembly at the start the day, before meeting their form tutor. This will be followed by three taster lessons, where the summer transition tasks will be introduced, and they will also be taken on a tour of the school. During the afternoon, all students will take part in House games on the field, organised by our Year 10 Sports Leaders. The aim of the day is to establish routines, expectations and to allay any worries students may have.

Students will also be supported on the day by Learning Support staff and the Year 7 Prefects, who are Year 13 students allocated to each of the form groups (one prefect per group). The prefects act as role models, mentors and offer general support to the students and form tutors.

The day will end at 2.30pm. Parents/carers are asked to wait in the turning circle outside the main entrance to the school and students will be brought out to parents/carers by their form tutors.

Please note that High Elms Lane will be very busy with parked cars and traffic. If you are not familiar with the lane, it reduces to a single track near The Shires and passing can be problematic. Please allow plenty of time and park away from the school to allow for a smooth departure.
