GCSE Assessments March/April Update

We are writing to remind you of the formal assessments that will take place this term, and at the very start of next term. These were shared just before half term, but please find details of timings below.

You will note that not all subjects are assessed. Where subjects have decided to go ahead with an assessment, this is usually because there was one or more elements of the qualification that was not assessed during the trial examinations. These assessments therefore provide students with the opportunity to revise, and be tested on, these parts of the course.

Further details of what is assessed in each paper will be provided via subject teachers. Please note that it is unlikely these will be precise revision lists, as students must be prepared for the full range of material that could be assessed in the summer. However, where topics / themes appear on specific GCSE exam papers, staff will be able to offer guidance.

The timings of the assessments are as follows:

Wednesday 1 March 10.30am	English Literature Paper 2 (An Inspector Calls, Power & Conflict Poetry and Unseen Poetry) (2hrs 15mins)
Wednesday 15 March 10.00am	Food Preparation & Nutrition (1hr 45 mins) Design & Technology (2hrs)
Thursday 16 March 9.15am	PE: Anatomy & Physiology, Movement Analysis and Commercialisation (1hr 15 mins)
Thursday 16 March 1.00pm	Business Paper 2 (1hr 45mins) Note: lunch will be early to accommodate this 1.00pm start time
Wednesday 29 March 11.15am	English Language Paper 1 (1hr 45mins)
Tuesday 18 April 10.00am	Maths Calculator Paper (1hr 30mins)

When not in an assessment, students will attend their normal timetabled lessons.


