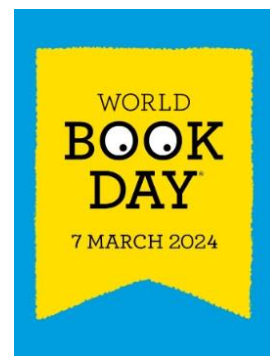

## WORLD BOOK DAY WEEK - 4 TO 8 MARCH 2024

We are extremely excited to share the schedule for all of the events and activities that will be going on in and around the LRC in March to celebrate World Book Day.

During every break and lunchtime during the week of 4 March, students can participate in various zones:

### Challenge Zone

- **Daily book-related challenges** – Challenges will be posted each day in the student notices. Every book challenge completed offers the chance to be entered in a draw to win a £5 Amazon voucher.
- **Daily pop-up book café** – We are hosting a book exchange again this year in the main LRC. Donated books from home that have been read and enjoyed are re-purposed so other students have the opportunity to enjoy them. **Each book donated will be exchanged for a token, which can be redeemed against another book on our café shelves**✳.
- **Enterprise Charity Sale** – Students will also be able to buy drinks and snacks at the book café bar.

✳Please drop donated books at Reception, marked clearly with your child's name, or ask your child to bring them to the LRC before registration, so that we can issue tokens in exchange.

- **Activity Passports** – Students can pick up an **activity passport from the LRC**. Completed activities will be signed off by a member of the library team. Students who complete 6 out of the 8 activities will be entered into a draw for TWO GOLDEN TICKETS.
- **World Book Day Bumper Quiz – Friday 8 March**. A chance for students to work together in teams in the Main LRC to compete for the coveted *Bumper Book Quiz Champions* GOLDEN TICKET. Each golden ticket will entitle the winner, plus up to 7 friends, to exclusive use of the library to watch a film or play board games. Bring your lunch! GOLDEN TICKET winners will be announced on the Accessit Library app on Monday 11 March.

### Creativity Zone

- **Monday Bookmark Workshop** – Be creative in making a bookmark inspired by your favourite read.
- **Tuesday Origami Workshop** – Learn a new skill of paper folding and make your own unique creation.
- **Wednesday Book Bunting workshop** – Be creative in designing book bunting art in teams to decorate reading corners of the library.
- **Thursday Old Book Page Project Workshop** – Upcycle old book pages into unique pieces of art.

- **Author Visit and Book sale** – On **Monday 4 March and Friday 8 March**, Year 7 students will enjoy a visit from Caroline Boxall, author of *The Runway Children of Chennai*. Students will have the opportunity to buy Caroline's books; details will be shared after half term.
- **BBC Young Reporter Workshop** - On **Wednesday 6 March**, some Year 8 and 9 students will have an opportunity to participate in the BBC Young Reporter Workshop.

### Competition Zone

All entries to be **handed into the Main LRC** by **1 March 2024**. All entries will go on display. Winner will receive a £10 Amazon Voucher.
- **Whole School Bookopoly Competition** - Introducing a whole school reading competition pitching forms against one another. We hope that Bookopoly will make reading fun and interactive and your form's teamwork skills will help you win. Whether you are an avid reader or a reluctant reader, you will want to join in. Information on how to play the game will be shared with students and staff before the game begins on **5 March 2024**. Bookopoly will run until **28 March 2024**. The first three forms to earn 100 Book Bucks wins. Winning forms will get a Golden Ticket for the exclusive use of the LRC at lunchtime, with cookies and entertainment.
