## Revision sessions for Year 11 (2019-2020)

ART	Open studio on <b>Thursday and Friday lunchtime</b> from <b>(1.20pm)</b> . Enrichment club every <b>Thursday</b> after school <b>until 4.30pm</b> .
COMPUTER SCIENCE	An extensive revision programme will take place in lessons from February half term until stand down.
	Students can attend extra revision sessions held on <b>Wednesday lunchtimes</b> in IT1 at <b>1.45pm</b> , starting after Easter.
D&T	An extensive revision programme will take place in lessons from 23 <sup>rd</sup> March until stand down. D&T staff will be available for individual support during D&T lesson time after stand down, by prior arrangement.
	Lunchtimes and after school sessions (which have run since September) have now finished as the NEA task has been completed.
DRAMA	Students will be invited to written revision sessions which will take place at lunchtime. Students will also be expected to commit to extra-curricular rehearsal in preparation for the practical parts of the course - these will take place during school hours.
ECONOMICS	Open revision sessions on <b>Monday</b> and <b>Tuesda</b> y lunchtimes from <b>1.45pm</b> with Mr Kennedy in P6. The focus will be on examination technique. All students can choose to attend on one of these days.
ENGLISH	Two revision groups will run on <b>Wednesday lunchtimes (1.45pm)</b> . The group in E5 will be by invite only; the group in E4 will be open to all interested students, on a first come, first served basis. A schedule of the topic/text to be covered will be made available to students in advance.
	In lessons, there is a focus on revising a different element of the course each fortnight, with examination practice embedded.
FOOD TECHNOLOGY	An extensive revision programme will take place in lessons from <b>16th March</b> until stand down. D&T/Food staff will be available for individual support during lesson time after stand down, by prior arrangement.
FRENCH	Foundation - Monday (1.45pm) in MFL6 with Ms O'Donnell. Higher - Monday (1.45pm) in ML5 with Mr Doherty.
GEOGRAPHY	Each Geography teacher will run their own revision drop-in clinic for their classes on <b>Tuesday lunchtimes (1.40pm)</b> in their usual classrooms up to stand down. Class teachers may run extra revision sessions nearer the exams. Targeted students will be invited to attend.
	Post stand-down, Geography students are welcome to use their usual lesson time to see their class teacher but they must email their teacher to let them know to expect them.
GERMAN	Tuesday lunchtime (1.45pm) in ML2 - Writing (Foundation and Higher) Wednesday lunchtime (1.45pm) in ML3 - Speaking (Foundation and Higher)
HISTORY	Revision classes every <b>Thursday lunchtime</b> with Miss Harris for students targeting grades 4-6. Revision classes every <b>Thursday lunchtime</b> with Miss Lincoln for students targeting grades 7-9. Specific students will be invited to attend mentoring with Y12.

MATHS	An extensive revision programme will take place in lessons until stand down. Lunchtime drop-in sessions open to all students will take place on <b>Tuesdays week 1</b> (in MA1 & MA3) and <b>Thursdays week 2</b> (in MA6 & MA8). In addition, individual teachers may arrange extra sessions for their classes at lunchtimes - students will be informed by their teacher.
MUSIC	Revision will take place in scheduled lessons. Additional sessions will be arranged after Easter, if required.
PE	Revision classes will take place on <b>Thursday lunchtimes (1.30pm - 2.10pm)</b> in the Function Room. There will be targeted revision opportunities for students invited during Tuesday registration. The Y12 students will support this.
RS	Teachers will consult with students and encourage them to complete examination answers. Google drive will be used to share good practice, post specimen answers and encourage students to complete examination answers. Students may also make arrangements to see staff when they are available. Further after-school or lunchtime sessions can also be arranged. Post stand down, students can arrange to see their teacher during the lesson time if they organise this in advance.
SCIENCE	Separate Science Biology- Tuesday week 2 (1.45pm) in S3 Separate Science Chemistry- Thursday week 2 (1.45pm) in S2 Separate Science Physics - Friday week 2 (1.45pm) in S9 Trilogy Science Drop-in - Monday week 2 (1.45pm) in S4 Trilogy Science session for invited students - Every Thursday (1.45pm) in S4
