Dear Year 10 Students and their Parents/Carers

Year 10 School Examinations (Wednesday 21 June - Wednesday 5 July 2023)

Please find the generic timetable for the Year 10 school examinations at the end of this letter. These examinations will provide an opportunity for students to demonstrate the progress they are making with their GCSE courses and identify specific areas of strength and weakness. Teachers will provide students with specific advice and guidance for revision. Revision skills are currently being explored during morning registration.

There is no study leave for these examinations. Students are expected to attend school each day, wearing full school uniform. When not in an examination, they will attend their normal lessons. Please avoid taking your child out of school for any appointments during this time.

In due course, students will be issued with a personal examination timetable showing only their examinations, the location of each examination and their seat number. Please note that this will not include details of their language oral examinations, as their languages teacher will provide them with the date and time of these. It is vital that students carefully read the examination timetable, highlighting all the examinations that are relevant to them.

If a student has special arrangements and/or support for their examinations, they will receive confirmation of these before half-term (these arrangements are known as 'access arrangements'), once they have been updated for this academic year. All students will be reminded about the procedures for examinations. However, we thought it would be helpful to highlight some key points:

- Students must ensure they bring all the required equipment for each examination/assessment. We will not supply forgotten equipment, including calculators.
- Only clear pencil cases may be taken into the examination room. Students must write in black ink.
- No electronic equipment (e.g. mobile phones, smart watches), other than calculators, may be taken into the examination room.
- No watches are allowed.
- Only clear water bottles, with labels removed, are permitted. No other drinks are allowed.
- During examinations, students may have to leave their bags unattended and are therefore advised not to bring valuable items into school. This does not include Chromebooks, as they are insured.
- If for any unavoidable reason a student is unable to attend school, or will be late, please contact the school as soon as possible.
