TO ALL STUDENTS WHO HAVE INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC LESSONS IN SCHOOL

Students in Years 7, 8 and 9 will usually have their instrumental lessons during the school day and miss general subject periods on a rotational basis. Music timetables for the whole term are displayed on the notice board in the Old Music Block. It is possible to see well in advance the times of lessons and plan accordingly. Any difficulties such as clashes with assessments, trips or medical appointments should be referred to your instrumental teacher at least a week in advance so that adjustments may be made. The charge for hiring school instruments is £20 per term.

GENERAL GUIDANCE FOR STUDENTS

- You should ask for permission from subject teachers to miss your classroom lessons to attend instrumental / singing lessons. Do not send a friend with a message, go yourself.
- Plan ahead. If your lesson clashes with a test or controlled assessment see your teacher to change your lesson time in advance.
- All work missed should be copied up.
- If there is homework set in the missed lesson you should find out what it is and make sure that it is completed satisfactorily and on time.
- Please do not make private arrangements to change lessons with other students, if you need to change your lesson ask your instrumental teacher..
- Check the date and time of your next lesson with your teacher every week and write it down.
- If you wish to give up lessons remember that notice **must** be given in writing **before** a half term. Music fees are due at the beginning of each term.
