Year12 Ecology Study Day at Field Studies Council, Epping Forest - Thursday 11th July 2019

As part of the A Level Biology course, we are running a day visit to the Field Studies Council centre in Epping Forest on Thursday 11th July 2019. The cost of this visit will be £42.00 and includes travel by coach and a day of instruction.

All students following the A Level Biology course are strongly advised to attend this field trip, as the instruction for the day will be covering the topic of Succession and focussing on the requirements of Required Practical 12 (Investigation into the effect of a named environmental factor on the distribution of a given species), with the FSC offering tuition by ecology experts and use of specialist equipment and resources.

Numbers are limited, so places will be allocated on a **first come, first served basis**. A non-refundable payment is required to secure your child's place. Please pay **£42.00** via WisePay (under Trips & Visits) or by cheque (made payable to Parmiter's School). Please write your child's **FULL NAME, FORM and 'Epping Ecology Day July 2019'** on the back of the cheque and return the payment to the Finance Box by **Friday 19th October**.

Should you decide at a future date to cancel your child's place (apart from the usual reasons covered by insurance such as illness or injury), the payment will not be refunded as bookings will have been secured well in advance of the trip date.

By paying, you are consenting to your child attending the above school trip. Please ensure the school is fully aware of any medical concerns you may have, under separate cover. Students must have any medications required (e.g. inhalers, anti-allergy medication) on the day of the trip.
