School Uniform Changes – Update

Following our previous communication regarding changes to school uniform from September 2019, a number of parents and students raised various queries. A decision was made to revisit this with the Governors. It has been decided that, from September, we will offer three options regarding student dress for Years 7 to 11.

Option A

Navy blue blazer, navy blue skirt, blue striped blouse, navy blue v-necked jumper (optional), black socks or tights and black shoes. Traditionally, this option was worn by the girls with a change to the socks.

Option B

Navy blue blazer, black trousers, white shirt, navy blue v-necked jumper (optional), school tie, black socks and black shoes. Traditionally, this option was worn by the boys with a change to the jumper.

Option C

Navy blue blazer, black trousers, white blouse (same neckline as striped blouse), navy blue-v necked jumper, black socks and black shoes.

Uniform expectations

Please note that trousers must be straight-legged, not skinny fit, boot-cut or flared. They must sit at the waist and should be the same style as sold by our two uniform suppliers, DJ Uniforms and Stevensons. Coats, hats, scarves and gloves must be navy blue or black. The only exception to this is the school scarf. Shoes must be black and regulation heel height. Boots of any kind are not allowed unless permission has been given by the school. Socks may not be worn over tights, shirts must be tucked in and ties worn with 4 stripes below the knot.

During extreme weather, concessions may be made regarding uniform and this will be communicated in advance.

Please refer to the Behaviour Policy for details regarding hair, make-up, jewellery and nails.

Our Parents' Association will continue to run their second-hand uniform sales. Please continue to donate good quality items as this not only helps raise vital funds for the school but also supports our families.

Thank you for your on-going support in maintaining the high standards of dress at Parmiter's School.
