A Level History & Politics Trip to Washington DC: October 2022

We are in the process of finalising the itinerary for the trip to Washington and have visits arranged for the White House, the Capitol, the Supreme Court and the National Archives. We are also attempting to secure additional visits to the new National Museum of African American History, as well as other walking tours of the key monuments and sights.

Once all the details have been confirmed, we will organise an information evening for parents/carers during the first few weeks of September. Information about the trip, including accommodation, travel arrangements, emergency contact details and the itinerary will be given out at the meeting and parents/carers will have an opportunity to ask any questions they may have.

Thank you for providing your child's passport and medical details. If any additional information is required, you will have received an email in this regard.

All students taking part in the trip will require a valid ESTA for their visit to the USA, which must be valid for the duration of our visit. ESTA applications can be made via the following link:
