### **GCSE Geography Field Trip to Swanage, Dorset, Wednesday 9 November to Friday 11 November 2022**

A GCSE Geography field trip to Swanage in Dorset will take place between 9 - 11 November 2022. The trip is essential and is designed to fulfil the obligatory fieldwork requirement in the syllabus we follow. Fieldwork will be undertaken at several sites in the area, including Chesil Beach, Lulworth Cove and Swanage. This location has been chosen for its stunning coastal landscape and the opportunities to study both physical and human geography.

We will depart from school at 9.00am on Wednesday 9 November and return by 3.00pm on Friday 11 November 2022. Travel will be by coach. During the trip we will be staying at Cumulus Outdoors field centre on a full board basis. The fieldwork activities will be led by myself and four other members of staff.

The total cost of the trip is **£176.00** per student, which covers the cost of accommodation, food (excluding lunch on the outward journey), travel and fieldwork equipment. Payment can be made via WisePay (under Trips and Visits) in full on or before **Friday 9 September** or in two instalments, the first instalment of **£88** being due by Monday 1 August and the second by Friday 9 September 2022. In addition, please complete the [Medical Form](#) by **Friday 9 September 2022** at the latest. By paying, you are consenting to your child taking part in the above school trip. Please note, if insufficient funds are raised, the trip may not run and alternative arrangements will have to be made.

Should you decide at a future date to cancel your child's place (apart from the usual reasons covered by insurance such as illness or injury) the deposit will not be refunded, as bookings will have been secured well in advance of the trip dates. The Headmaster reserves the right to withdraw any student at any stage from the trip, where he considers that the safety or benefit of this experience could be spoilt by an individual student's presence. If your child withdraws from the visit, the school decides to remove your child from the visit for a breach of discipline, or your child is removed from the visit because a concern exists about your child's suitability to partake in the activities, some or all of the monies paid will be lost.
