Year 7 Humanities Trip to the Tower of London: June 2024

The Humanities Faculty has organised a day trip to visit the Tower of London, which links to the Year 7 History and Personal Development curriculum. The visit will include an education session led by an expert presenter.

The cost of the trip is £22 per student. Please make your payment via WisePay (under Trips and Visits) by Friday 20 October.

On the day, students will need to wear full **school uniform**. They will also need **a packed lunch** and something to drink. As some of the activities will be outside, we recommend the use of sun protection cream and provision of waterproof clothing. Students are not advised to bring large amounts of money or valuable items (such as ipods or mobile phones) with them, as we will have no facilities for storing them securely. The school cannot be held responsible for any loss or damage to equipment.

We will travel by coach, leaving school at **8.40am** and returning at approximately **3.15 pm**, in time for students to catch the school buses.

By paying, you are consenting to your child taking part in the above school trip. Please ensure the school is fully aware of any medical concerns you may have, under separate cover. Please note: parents must provide all indate medication for their child, for example, Epipens, antihistamines and asthma inhalers, for the trip. Students must have their medication with them at all times, if required.

May we take this opportunity to reiterate that this payment fully commits your child to the trip and no refunds will be given if your child pulls out, except as a direct and necessary result of any cause outside of the student's control (for example, if required to self-isolate in line with government guidance or serious illness/injury). If your child subsequently decides not to take part in the visit, you will lose all monies paid.
