## Year 7 Geography Visit to the Natural History Museum

The Geography Department has arranged a one-day, educational visit for Year 7 students to the Natural History Museum in London. This is a compulsory school trip, which will run in conjunction with the Humanities Tower of London trip and the dates are as follows:

This visit aims to inspire and inform our students about different elements of the Geography curriculum, specifically Biomes and Ecosystems, which we will be studying in due course. This trip will provide an excellent opportunity for students to develop their understanding of Geography away from the classroom, benefitting from the vast array of exhibits which are on display at the Natural History Museum, and also support other units studied at Key Stage 3, specifically Tectonic Hazards and learning about the future of our world.

We will travel by coach, leaving Parmiter's at **8.40am** and returning at approximately **3.15pm**. This will enable students to get the school buses home, if applicable.

On the day, students will need to wear full school uniform, including black school shoes. They will also need to bring **a packed lunch** and something to drink. Students are not advised to bring large amounts of money or valuable items (ipods, mobile phones) with them, as we will have no facilities for storing them securely. The school cannot be held responsible for loss or damage to equipment.

The cost of the trip is £12.50 per student. Please make your payment via WisePay (under Trips and Visits) by 20 May 2024.

By paying, you are consenting to your child taking part in the above school trip. Please ensure the school is fully aware of any medical concerns you may have, under separate cover. Please note: parents must provide all in-date medication for their child, for example, Epipens, antihistamines and asthma inhalers, for the trip. Students must have their medication with them at all times, if required.
