Sport Leaders LEVEL 2 Qualification 2024 – 2025

As part of the Year 10 Physical Education syllabus, all students will complete a minimum of an 8 week Sports Leadership course. The courses offered (Sports Leaders Level 1 and Level 2) are accredited awards run by Sports Leaders UK, who provide nationally recognised leadership qualifications. The awards encourage students to understand and develop essential life skills, such as communication, planning, evaluating and teamwork. It is expected that students will then apply these skills by volunteering their time and assisting with Key Stage 3 extra-curricular clubs.

Due to your child's excellent commitment and participation in PE lessons and extra-curricular sport, they have been selected for the Sports Leaders **Level 2** award. In order to achieve the award, students will complete a unit of work over one half term and then have a drop down day where they will be off timetable for one day. Once students have finished the course they are assessed on their ability to plan and deliver a one-hour session in their chosen activity, as well as organising and running a sports event. Both of these requirements will be completed in school. Finally, Level 2 students will need to complete a log book to show they have volunteered for at least 10 hours leading or assisting in the running of sports sessions outside or within school.

The cost of the course is **£38.00**, which we recommend is paid so that your child receives the official accreditation. If you do not wish to pay, then your child will complete the Parmiter's Leadership Award, which has no national recognition.

Please make your payment of **£38.00** via **WisePay** (under Clubs and Activities).

By paying, you are consenting to your child taking part in the above qualification. Please ensure the school is fully aware of any medical concerns you may have, under separate cover. Please note: parents must provide all in-date medication for their child, for example, Epipens, antihistamines and asthma inhalers, for the duration of the course. Students must have their medication with them at all times, if required.
