Dear Parents and Carers

Year 12 Art Trip to Paris - Thursday 21 to Saturday 23 May 2026

We are very excited to launch our Year 12 Art trip to Paris, which will be a fantastic opportunity for students to explore the country's art, architecture and culture. The trip will act as a stimulus to inform their upcoming projects in Year 13 and is designed to inspire and expand their artistic vision through painting, drawing and photography, and enable students to record first-hand experiences that can be embedded into their work. The provisional itinerary includes visits to the Sacre Coeur Basilica, Montmartre, Musee D'Orsay, Petite Palais, Musée, National Picasso Museum and the Eiffel Tower. Details may change, but we will keep you informed.

The initial cost of the trip is **£495** and includes travel via Eurostar, transfers, all meals, accommodation and entry to all the exhibitions. To secure a place on this trip, we ask that you make the **deposit payment of £165** via [WisePay](#) and complete the [medical form](#) by **no later than Friday 28 November** and then strictly adhere to the payment schedule below. We require a minimum number of students to make this trip viable or we may not be able to go ahead, in which case all monies paid will be refunded.

Please note that, as per entry requirements to France, if you are travelling on a UK passport then your passport must be valid for at least 6 months after Saturday 23 May 2026. The final details and itinerary will be given out during the Information Evening in June (date tbc).

By paying, you are consenting to your child taking part in the above school trip. May we take this opportunity to reiterate that this payment fully commits your child to the trip and no refunds will be given if your child pulls out, except as a direct and necessary result of any cause outside of the student's control (for example serious illness/injury). If your child subsequently decides not to take part in the visit, you will lose all monies paid to date unless a replacement student can be found to fill the place. We reserve the right to remove any student from the trip if the above payment schedule is not met.

The safety and well-being of the students is our prime consideration. We hope this will be a successful and enjoyable trip that gives your child the best possible start to their new project. Therefore, in the lead-up to the trip, all places will be subject to the lead teacher's satisfaction that the student is a suitable representative of the school.
