### **Art & Textiles Study Trip to The Warner Brothers Studio - The Making of Harry Potter**

The Faculty of Art & Textiles is very excited to be running a trip to Warner Brothers Studio. The aim of the trip is to provide students with an insight into creative career opportunities within the film and TV industry and to research various roles within the business. All students will take part in a workshop that looks at these possibilities, before commencing the tour. It is anticipated that all Year 8 students will take part in this event and they will be off timetable all day, there will be no lessons running.

The trip will run over a period of four days, with two form groups taking part each day as follows:

Wednesday 22 April	8A (KCL) & 8B (KPO)
Tuesday 5 May	8C (SCI) & 8D (JHO)
Wednesday 6 May	8E (ICH) & 8F (EWI)
Monday 11 May 11	8G (MWO) & 8H (BSW)

We will travel by coach, leaving school at 9.00am and returning by the end of the school day. Students will need to wear full, smart school uniform. They will also need a small backpack, a packed lunch and something to drink. Some time will be spent outside, so provision of suitable outdoor clothing is recommended. Students will also need to bring their pencil case, **no sharp objects or scissors please** as these will be confiscated at the security bag check area. Chromebooks should be left at home. We anticipate a short visit to the gift shop on the way out, but must reiterate that any money and other valuables taken on the trip will be the responsibility of the student.

The cost of the trip is **£29.00** per student. Please make your payment via [Wisepay](#) (under Trips & Visits) before **Friday 28 November 2025**.

**May we take this opportunity to reiterate that this payment fully commits your child to the trip and no refunds will be given if your child pulls out, except as a direct and necessary result of any cause outside of the student's control (for example, if required to self-isolate in line with government guidance or serious illness/injury). If your child subsequently decides not to take part in the visit, you will lose all monies paid.**

**By paying, you are consenting to your child taking part in the above school trip. Please ensure the school is fully aware of any medical concerns you may have, under separate cover. Please note: parents must provide all in date medication for their child, for example, Epipens, antihistamines and asthma inhalers, for the trip. Students must have their medication with them at all times, this will be checked on the morning of their visit and students will not be allowed to take part if they do not have their medication.**

**Please note that, whilst places are available for everyone in the year group, if behaviour falls short of that expected of Parmiter's students, a student's place and all monies paid will be forfeited. The Headteacher reserves the right to withdraw any student from the visit, at any stage, where he considers that the safety or benefit of this experience could be compromised by an individual student's presence.**
