Dear Parents and Carers

Disneyland Paris Netball Festival Trip - Easter 2027

We are delighted to offer our current Year 7 and 8 students a fantastic opportunity to travel to Disneyland Paris to take part in an International Junior Netball Tournament, with expert coaching sessions by Elite Netball. We have reserved 40 student places for the 5-day tour, which will run from **Tuesday 30 March to Saturday 3 April 2027 (Easter)**, and we hope to secure enough interest to confirm the trip.

This venture has been organised with the team at Sport Experiences, who have more than 25 years in the educational and sport travel industry. Many of the Sport Experiences team are parents themselves, who fully understand the need to feel that your money is not only secure but also invested in an experience your child will treasure for many years. Sport Experiences is fully ABTOT and ATOL bonded, plus a member of ABTA. They are also members of the School Travel Forum, which regulates safety and service standards, and they have been awarded the Learning Outside the Classroom quality badge.

The cost of the trip is **£1 006** per student and includes:

- Five days coach travel
- Return Channel crossings
- Travel insurance
- Four nights' accommodation, including a continental buffet breakfasts each morning
- Packed lunches delivered on days 2 and 3 to the sports venue
- Evening meal at the Disney Village on day 2
- Evening meal at the hotel on day 3
- Lunch and Awards Ceremony, including trophy presentations on day 4
- One day Hopper Ticket to Disneyland Park and Walt Disney Studios Park.
- International Junior Netball Tournament Pool, Play-Offs and Finals matches
- Team and individual skills development coaching clinics
- Masterclasses with Elite Netball
- Training kit

If you would like to apply for a place for your child on this trip, please complete the [Expression of Interest Form](#) by **Friday 5 December 2025**. If your child is offered a place on the trip, a **deposit payment of £50** will be due by **Friday 12 December 2025** and, failure to meet this deadline, will result in the place being withdrawn and offered to the next student on the list. A payment schedule will be issued to those students who are offered a place.

Please note that the initial deposit fully commits your child to the trip and no refunds will be given if, at a later date, you wish to cancel your child's place, except as a direct and necessary result of any cause outside of the student's control (for example, if required to self-isolate in line with government guidance or serious illness/injury). If your child subsequently decides not to take part in the visit, you will lose all monies paid to date unless a replacement student can be found to fill the place. If a replacement can be found, then any costs incurred for altering the passenger details will be deducted from the refund given.
