A Level Geography NEA (non-examined assessment) Fieldtrip 2026

<i>Day 1 - Monday 18 May 2026</i>	<i>Epping Forest, Carbon Sequestration study</i>
<i>Day 2 - Tuesday 19 May 2026</i>	<i>Stratford in London, Regeneration and Globalisation study</i>
<i>Day 3 - Wednesday 20 May 2026</i>	<i>Cassiobury Park in Watford, Water study</i>
<i>Day 4 - Monday 15 June 2026</i>	<i>Epping Forest, Carbon Sequestration data collection day (depending on which NEA your child has chosen)</i>
<i>Day 5 - Tuesday 16 June 2026</i>	<i>Stratford in London, Regeneration and Globalisation data collection day, or Cassiobury Park in Watford, Water data collection day (depending on which NEA your child has chosen)</i>

The four, day trips are designed to fulfil the obligatory component of fieldwork required by the syllabus we follow. In accordance with the Edexcel A Level Geography syllabus, essential fieldwork skills in both physical and human geography topics will be addressed during these trips, to allow students to complete their primary data collection required for their NEA (coursework). Therefore, **this is a compulsory requirement of the course and all students are expected to attend.** The fieldwork activities will be led by Mrs Clark and Mrs Everitt.

Students are expected to meet at the agreed meeting points and times listed below:

- **Days 1 and 4** - students are expected to meet at school in the Geography department by **8.30am** at the latest. We will return to Parmiter's in time for students to catch the school buses home, if necessary.
- **Days 2 and 5** - students are expected to meet at the agreed meeting point on the steps leading towards Westfield Shopping Centre outside Stratford train station and opposite Stratford Shopping Centre entrance (What3words code:[length.bland.impose](#)) by **10.00am**. Fieldwork should be completed by 4.00pm at the latest.
- **Days 3 and 5** - students are expected to meet at Cassiobury Park entrance at the end of Langley Way, where it meets Parkside Drive and Coningsby Drive (What3words code:[mild.really.wires](#)) by **9.30am**. Fieldwork should be completed by 2.45pm at the latest.

Students will need to bring a packed lunch on each of the four field trip days. Travel to be organised independently by the students. Should students require any help with travel arrangements, then Mrs Clark, Mr Bunce and Mrs Everitt will be happy to help out where needed.

The cost of the trip is **£75.00** per student, which will cover the admin fee and fieldwork equipment requirement. **Please note that travel will be at your own expense and dependent on the mode of transport used by your child.** Please make your payment of **£75.00** via [WisePay](#) (under Trips & Visits) and complete the [consent form](#) by **Friday 24 April 2026**.

Students must have any in-date medication, e.g. Epipens, antihistamines and asthma inhalers, with them at all times if needed. Please advise the school office of any changes in health or medical conditions and emergency contact telephone numbers.
