Save the Date! On **Friday 10 July**, we will be hosting a **Careers Fair** at Parmiter's.

This event is designed to be a celebration of our work and the thriving relationships we share within both our local community and the wider Parmiter's family. We want to showcase the variety of career sectors available to our students, opening their eyes to the breadth of future opportunities available for them.

All students in Years 9, 10 and 12 will be attending the Fair during the school day. We are also holding an after-school session where parents/carers and students from all year groups can attend.

There are two ways you can get involved:

1. Attend the Fair with your Child/ren

We invite you to come along, explore the exhibition stands and chat with a wide range of businesses and organisations. We have two dedicated visiting windows:

- **During the School Day (2.20pm – 3.20pm):** Parents and carers of students in **Years 9, 10 and 12** are very welcome to join us during this time.
- **After School (3.45pm – 5.30pm):** This session is open to **all parents and carers across any year group**. The 3.45pm start is to allow for after-school traffic to depart, so that you can arrive and park more easily. Your children will be able to wait on the concourse for you to arrive after school.

2. Showcase Your Business and Career

To make this event a true reflection of our community, we would also like to offer you the opportunity to have your own stand at the Fair. This is an excellent opportunity to:

- Promote your business or organisation to the wider school community.
- Talk to students about your industry and inspire them about their future career paths.
- Highlight potential opportunities, such as future work experience, apprenticeships, or employment.

We want as much representation from different sectors as possible, whether your business is large or small, local or further afield. Tables will be provided for stands and you are welcome to bring along your own promotional equipment.
