GCSE History Revision

To support our students with the GCSE History course, the department is committed to providing the best possible support with their revision efforts. To this end, we will be utilising the revision app, Tassomai, in the build up to the examinations.

Tassomai and its Benefits:

- **Targeted Revision:** Tassomai focuses on low-stakes recall quizzes, a technique proven to enhance long-term memory retention.
- **Manageable Workload:** We anticipate that completing the weekly Tassomai goal will take approximately 20-30 minutes, equivalent to a typical homework length.
- **Comprehensive Coverage:** Given the vast amount of content covered in GCSE History, Tassomai offers a structured and efficient way to revise key information.
- **Individualised Revision:** Tassomai uses a unique algorithm to test students more regularly on their weakest topics, whilst interleaving all important content.

All GCSE History students are expected to complete their weekly Tassomai goal and classroom teachers will monitor individual student progress every Monday for the preceding week. Students who fail to meet their weekly Tassomai goals will be issued with an appropriate sanction, in line with the homework policy.

We understand that the examination period can be a stressful time for both students and their parents/carers but, by incorporating Tassomai into their revision routine, students can effectively solidify their understanding of the course content and ultimately boost their confidence and performance in the GCSE History examinations. We encourage you to discuss this initiative with your child and offer support in ensuring they complete their weekly Tassomai goals.
