**A Level Art Study Visit to the Tate Modern (Experiencing the inspiring work of Julio Le Parc)
Monday 12 October 2026**

To support and extend students' coursework at A Level, we have organised a study visit to the Tate Modern Gallery in London on Monday 12 October to look at the works of Julio Le Parc along with other artists. After visiting the exhibition, students will have an opportunity to photograph areas around London Bridge and the Tate to enhance their current coursework projects. This is an excellent opportunity to further develop recording skills and photograph subject matters or scenes that link to current work.

The cost of the trip is **£13, which includes admission to a private exhibition**. Students will need to make their own way to and from the gallery. **Our meeting point will be outside the Tate Modern at the Turbine Hall entrance, which is located on Holland Street, London SE1 9TG, right off the pedestrianised Thames riverfront.** Students will need to bring sufficient money/or a contactless payment card to cover their travel costs. They will also need to bring a packed lunch or money to buy lunch.

The itinerary is as follows:

13:30	Photography shoot around London Bridge and the Tate Modern area of London - led by the Art teacher.
14:40	Walk to the tube station for the return journey.

Students should be sensibly, but casually dressed and they will need to bring a camera or phone to take photographs. Any valuables are taken entirely at the student's own risk.
