Dear Parents and Carers

Year 9 and 10 Drama Trip to 'Beetlejuice The Musical' – Wednesday 14 October 2026

The Drama Department is delighted to be able to offer a theatre experience for Year 9 and 10 students. We have been able to obtain discounted tickets to see 'Beetlejuice The Musical' at The Prince Edward Theatre on Wednesday 14 October. The age guidance for this production is 12+, however, given the nature of the themes, we advise parents to exercise their own judgment regarding suitability for their child/ren.

Students will need to meet on the Plaza at 5.00pm and we will travel by coach to and from the theatre, returning to Parmiter's at approximately 11.15pm. The performance begins at 7.30pm and the run time is approximately 2 hours and 40 minutes (which includes an interval). Students will need to be collected from the Sports Centre car park upon our return. Please leave enough room for the coaches to turn around, when parking.

Students do not need to wear school uniform, but should dress appropriately. Students may take a **rucksack size bag** into the venue (*please note that bags may be searched upon entering the venue*) and they may bring snacks (**nut products are prohibited**) and a drink. Students will have an opportunity to purchase refreshments at the theatre but, please note, the theatre is a cashless venue.

The cost of the trip is **£32**, which covers the cost of the ticket and travel to and from the theatre. If your child would like to take part in this event, please make your payment via [WisePay](#) (under Trips and Visits).

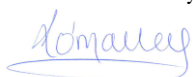
Tickets will be available to purchase from 7.00pm on Monday 14 September 2026. Tickets will be offered on a **first come, first served** basis. If your child is unsuccessful in being offered a place for this theatre trip, we will make every effort to prioritise these students on future theatre trips. This approach will help ensure that, over time, as many students as possible have the opportunity to take part in these experiences.
