Dear Parents and Carers

A Level German Trip to Nuremberg - Thursday 3 to Sunday 6 December 2026

As part of their A Level studies in German, we would like to offer your child a place on a residential visit to the historically significant city of Nuremberg from Thursday 3 to Sunday 6 December 2026.

Students will experience the city of Nuremberg and its surrounding area, as well as take in a number of the region's famous Christmas markets which is part of the A Level syllabus. They will also have the opportunity to practise and develop the German they have learnt in the classroom. During the trip, we will see many of the most famous sights in Nuremberg such as the castle, the old town, the German National Museum and explore the Nazi Party Grounds. We also intend to take our students to a sports fixture, as well as exploring some of the other towns and cities in Bavaria.

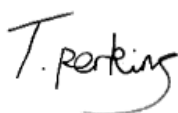
It is not possible to provide a final costing for the trip at this stage, but we estimate that it should cost no more than **£650** (this does not include spending money and the cost of lunches and dinners). If your child would like to take part in this trip, please make an initial deposit payment of **£250** via [WisePay](#) (under Trips & Visits) and complete the [Medical Form](#) by **Friday 18 September 2026**.

We are aware of the short payment time-frame, which is due to flights and accommodation needing to be booked as soon as possible. Once the final cost has been confirmed, a payment schedule will be sent out to those who have paid the deposit and is likely to consist of two further payments on Friday 16 October and Friday 13 November 2026. The deposit payment will be non-refundable if the trip goes ahead as planned. If, for financial or staffing reasons, we are unable to run the trip then the deposit payment will be refunded.

By paying, you are consenting to your child taking part in the above school trip. May we take this opportunity to reiterate that payment fully commits your child to the trip and no refunds will be given, except as a direct and necessary result of any cause outside of the student's control (for example, if required to self-isolate in line with government guidance or serious illness/injury). If your child subsequently decides not to take part in the visit, you will lose all monies paid to date unless a replacement student can be found to fill the place. If a replacement can be found, then any costs incurred for altering the passenger details for the flight will be deducted from the refund given. We reserve the right to remove any student from the trip if required payments are not met.

As per the entry requirements in Germany, if you are travelling on a UK passport then your passport must be valid for at least six months after Sunday 6 December 2026.
