Dear Parents and Carers

Design & Technology Residential Visit to Disneyland Paris – January 2027

We are pleased to provide details of the **optional** Year 10 & 12 Design & Technology residential visit to Disneyland Paris planned for January 2027. **This trip is not a compulsory part of the Design & Technology course.**

We will visit Disneyland Park and Disney Adventure World, and gather primary research for a Disney based project in school. Students will also attend a STEM Live Event, which will include leading industry professional speakers, offer advice for examination preparation, industry advice on future career opportunities, linking the curriculum with the real world. **Please be assured that no student will be at a disadvantage if they do not take part in this trip.**

Full details, including the final itinerary, will be confirmed in early 2027. However, the cost includes return coach and ferry travel from school to Disneyland Paris, bed and breakfast accommodation at Disney Hotel Cheyenne, two-day ticket to both parks, a trip hoodie, the STEM Live event and an evening meal on days one and two. Some spending money will need to be set aside for lunches and snacks whilst we are away.

The visit to Disneyland Paris will be run by the Design & Technology Department, in conjunction with school travel operators NST. The details for this optional visit are as follows:

Dates: Sunday 31 January – Tuesday 2 February 2027
Hotel: Disney Hotel Cheyenne
Cost: In the Region of £690.00 (subject to final number of participants)

Please be aware that, to run this trip, we require a minimum number of students to sign up to make it cost effective. If there is insufficient demand, we will be unable to run the trip. However, if too many students wish to take part, we will operate a reserve list. Places will be allocated at the discretion of the school and we will not enter into discussion about why a student has not been allocated a place. We reserve the right to refuse a place if the student is not an excellent ambassador of the school. Any student who does not show exceptional behaviour in and around school in the lead up to the trip, may be refused a place.

If you would like your child to be considered for a place on this trip, please make the deposit payment of **£250** via [WisePay](#) (under Trips & Visits) **by no later than Friday 2 October 2026**. If your child is in receipt of Pupil Premium funding, please contact the Finance Office (finance@parmiters.herts.sch.uk) in confidence by **Friday 18 September 2026**.

If your child is allocated a place, you will need to strictly adhere to the payment schedule below to enable us to pay the travel company as required:
