True Adventure 2028 Information Evening – Tuesday 13 October 2026

This summer, we had two teams taking part in overseas expeditions in Tanzania and both were extremely successful. We are proud to say that our students were a credit to the school in terms of their personal development and the sustainable contribution they made to the rural communities we visited.

The True Adventure expeditions in **July 2028** are being offered to all students currently in Years 10 to 12. What sets this apart from other school trips is that students have the added responsibility of fundraising to secure their place on the team and leading the expedition whilst in Tanzania or Borneo.

A **True Adventure Information Evening** will be held on **Tuesday 13 October** at **7.00pm** in the **School Hall**.

This will be an informative and interactive presentation, with images from previous expeditions showing what it will be like to take part, and you will also have an opportunity to ask questions. - Project work with *Better Lives* Charity in Tanzania
- Marine conservations projects in Borneo

Both expeditions will also involve an SSI open water diving course.
