Freda Waters Memorial Prize for Drama. Endowed in 2014 by Grahame Waters, Headmaster from 1967 to 1982. Awarded for outstanding performance in Drama practical examinations: **Louis Strugnell**

Frank Collins Prize for Economics. Endowed in 1993 in memory of Mr Frank Collins MBE, an Old Parmiterian who attended the School during the 1920s.
